

## **REVIEW OF THE DRUG AND ALCOHOL PREVENTION AND TREATMENT SERVICES SECTOR**

### **COMMUNIQUÉ No. 3 – 8 MARCH 2014**

The Advisory Committee met face-to-face in Canberra at an all-day meeting on Friday 14 February 2014. At the meeting, the project team updated members on the progress of the review of the drug and alcohol prevention and treatment services sector (the review). The Advisory Committee discussed Working Papers 4, 5 and 6 on Commonwealth grant schemes, Pay-for-performance, and Hard to count / unrecorded treatment.
